Using

```
grid.AddColumn("option").Option()
```

I got a simply two state.

Modifying the library method MakeOption and adding .ThreeState() the problem is resolved

```
static void MakeOption(One<Ctrl>& ctrl)
{
    ctrl.Create<Option>().ThreeState().ShowLabel(false);
    ctrl->SetData(0);
    ctrl->WantFocus();
}
```

However I would ask to Daniel to consider adding a new method to get the ThreeState when desired. For example

```
.Option(bool threestate=false)
```
