Hi Koldo,

yes, this works, too.

But I think we can leave out the extern "C" { ... } declarations since `__cdecl` already instructs the compiler to use C calling conventions (see <http://msdn.microsoft.com/en-us/library/zkwh89ks%28v=vs.80%29.aspx>).

So the following would be enough to include at the top of `parser.cpp` or even in `Core.h`:

```
#if defined(COMPILER_MINGW)
_CRTIMP unsigned int __cdecl __MINGW_NOTHROW _clearfp(void);
#define SW_OVERFLOW 0x00000004
#endif
```

It even builds correctly without `__cdecl` under my configuration.
