I have tested another, and this it comes out to me well. I take the feasible one with `execl`, of this form:

```
void onLaunchExe()
{
    String exe = "/media/GIGANTE/DSRLLLO/upp/out/GCC32.Debug_full.Gui.Shared/testDLL_EXE" ;
    int status ;
    pid_t pid = fork() ;
    if (pid > 0)
    {
        execl( exe, exe, " This is all, folks!!!", NULL ) ;
        // I hope to wait to secondary program finish ...
    }
}
```

In this case the both windows works fine, but this was not what I wanted to obtain.
