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Hi all!

I was looking for a simple replace function - after a while of searching found such function in "TCore". But what I want to do doesn't work - maybe I do something wrong:

I have some Strings ...

```
Vector<String> Lines;
```

... and fill them ...

```
Lines = Split(LargeStringFromFile, ASeparator, false);
```

... and now I want to replace something in each line:

```
for (int i = 0; i < Lines.GetCount(); i++)  
{  
    Lines.At(i) = StringReplace(Lines.At(i), "Something", "SomethingElse");  
}
```

Lines.At(i) seems to do not contain what I expect. Some suggestions?
